Vega A - Gib'sea 364

Vega A combines excellent sailing characteristics with a high standard of spacious accommodation. She was specifically chosen for the fleet because of her suitability for charter and sailing tuition. The large cockpit is particularly ideal.

The sail plan and rig, combined with the deep keel make this yacht an ideal choice to sail in any conditions. She has a balanced helm with the right amount of weather helm to make it a safe and enjoyable sail.

Spacious living accommodation for up to eight people, six in good sized double berths and a convertible double berth in the saloon, is complemented by two heads, each featuring a lavatory, wash basin and shower facility. The kitchen area is well equipped with a double burner gas cooker and oven, large icebox and a double stainless steel sink.

Vega A is equipped with wheel steering. The instruments mounted in front of the helmsperson indicate wind direction / speed and depth. An autohelm / autopilot system is also fitted to the craft.
